

## **Schedule for Entry of 1<sup>st</sup> year MS students (2021-2023 batch) At NIPER-SAS Nagar, Punjab**

A total of **273** MS students of (2021-2023 batch) shall be called starting  
**From 10<sup>th</sup> November 2021 till 15 December 2021**

**Place of Quarantine:**Respective hostel room

**Quarantine period:** 03 days

**Date of Entry to Deptt./Lab:** on 4<sup>th</sup> Day(*After submission of health assessment form to Chief Warden Office*)

The newly admitted MS students of 2021-2023 batch (273) shall join NIPER S.A.S. Nagar **from 10<sup>th</sup> November 2021**, subject to the following:

- The MS students who have been vaccinated with 02 doses of vaccine will only be permitted to join the NIPER, S.A.S. Nagar.
- The students who are vaccinated with only 01 dose of vaccine can join later once they are fully vaccinated with 02 doses of vaccine. No email correspondence in this regard (*regarding joining prior to completion of 02 doses of vaccination*) will be entertained.

### **BEFORE ARRIVAL:**

- Before starting their onward journey to NIPER, S.A.S. Nagar, the students (having 02 doses of vaccine) are required to submit the following details and documents to masters2021@niper.ac.in with a copy to respective hostel warden email ID:
  - Travel plan and the registration number
  - Undertaking form duly signed by the student, guide, HoD and parents (in pdf format).
  - Copy of Final vaccination certificate (in pdf format)
  - Copy of RT-PCR Negative test report (not older than 72 hours) at the main gate on the day of their arrival/mail in advance to masters2021@niper.ac.in, if available. The report can be shown on the mobile, if the report is received during transit period.
- The students are required to submit the copy of the Undertaking form, Final certificate and RT-PCR at the main gate, upon their arrival.
- The hostel wise room allotment will be uploaded on the NIPER website shortly.

- The respective warden, after scrutinizing the documents, will grant permission to enter the campus. No student will enter the campus, before the written permission from the respective Warden.

### **DURING 03 DAYS QUARANTINE:**

- The students are required to mandatorily fill the 'self-health monitoring/assessment proforma (Copy enclosed) and submit the same at the end of 3 days to respective wardens along with permission to join the lab as well as Hostel mess.
- During Quarantine period students are strictly required to remain at their hostel rooms and order food from the Cafeteria/Chenab messon payment basis to their respective rooms for the quarantine period of 03 days.

### **THE DOS AND DONT'S DURING THE QUARANTINE PERIOD FOR THE STUDENTS:**

1. The quarantine should be followed strictly in letter and spirit.
2. No student is allowed to mix with each other, engage in group activities like chit-chatting in corridors of the hostel, playing any sort of sports in the hostel premises, eating together in individual rooms. Students must wear a proper mask all the time once they step out of their room to collect drinking water, collecting food, etc., and follow social distancing norms. Students are also not allowed to step out of hostel premises during their quarantine.
3. Food will be delivered at the entry of every block of the hostel by the cafeteria/hostel mess. No rush is allowed to pick the food. Students are required to follow the discipline and collect it one by one.
4. During the quarantine period of 03 days, the students are required to monitor their temperature and oxygen saturation level and record in health assessment form. The students should also follow social distancing norms and wearing proper masks.

- I shall strictly follow the guideline of not travelling home town/any other out station visit for 6 months. I shall visit outside locally/out of station (home town/any other visit out station) only in case of medical emergency. The nature of emergency will be substantiated by my supervisor/HoD.
- I shall strictly follow the guidelines issued by NIPER in case of out station visits. I shall submit COVID-19 negative test report (RT-PCR) not older than 72 hours done at home town upon my arrival at NIPER-SAS Nagar. Also as per notified guidelines I shall undergo quarantine for 03 days in my allotted hostel room.
- I am not having fever, cough and breathing problem (from last 2 weeks).
- I am not having any disease like diabetes/hypertension/heart/lung/kidney related disease etc.
- I will wear proper face mask and I will sanitize my hands regularly
- I will maintain physical/social distancing in my class room/Laboratories/academic area/ hostels and in NIPER, S A S Nagar campus and strictly follow covid appropriate behaviour all the time.
- I will use AarogyaSetu and Cova Apps on my mobile and they will remain active at all times (through Bluetooth and Wi-Fi)
- I will self-monitor my health every day after I return to the Institute. In case, I develop fever, cough, flu-like symptoms and/or breathing problem then I will inform about it to my supervisor /In-Charge/Head of department etc. Also I will consult a doctor and follow medical advice.
- I understand that there is always a possibility of getting infected by the virus. My parents/guardians are also fully aware of my wish to continue my research work at the institute during the covid pandemic.

- I shall not engage in any sports activities, gatherings, arrange any sort of short parties (including birthday etc.). If found violating any of the guidelines above I shall be liable to be acted upon as per the approved covid-19 guidelines of NIPER-SASNagar.
- I also understand that NIPER, S A S Nagar has very limited medical facilities with doctor available for limited time on selected days only. **SOP/INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING THE HOSTEL/MESS  
FOR THE MASTERS STUDENTS (2021-2023 BATCH)**

1. It is solely voluntary by the students to come back to NIPER campus and/or resume academic activities/attend labs at their own which and in no way the institute shall be held responsible for any happenings to the students in this regard.
2. Accompanying person(s), parents, guardians or any guests will not be allowed in hostel premises. Parents/accompanying persons will be allowed only to drop their ward at the respective hostel and must leave the campus immediately. The parents/accompanying persons should make their own arrangements for boarding/lodging outside.
3. Upon entry into NIPER, the allowed students must quarantine at their respective hostel rooms for 03 days.
4. Students will not be allowed to go out of station including hometown in any case for six months (upto April 2022) after their entry in NIPER.
5. Student should follow strictly all covid-19 guidelines or advisory issued by NIPER administration from time to time and co-operate in all instances during their stay at the institute.
6. Students should not roam around the campus un-necessarily and follow appropriate behaviour expected from students of higher learning institutes.
7. Students will not be allowed to occupy their rooms in hostels without permission of the wardens.
8. Any type of social gathering (any sort of small parties in more than 2 numbers for example birthday parties etc.) or celebration of festivals in groups are not permitted and strictly prohibited.
9. After completion of Quarantine period every student must compulsorily mark their outgoing and incoming entries in the movement register kept at the hostel security desk.
10. In case of any violation of above guidelines, suitable action will be taken by authorities that include monetary fine Rs. 500 for first time violation, Rs. 1000 for second time violation and as well as sending the students back to home if the violation is repeated for the third time.
11. The students may bring their own bedding and bucket etc. else the students can also order/purchase these items from the tuck shops available on the campus.
