

NIRF 2022 Rankings

National Institutional Ranking Framework or NIRF India Rankings 2022 were announced by Honorable Education Minister, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, on 15.07.2022. The MHRD released NIRF rankings for higher educational institutes across ten different categories and overall. The rankings were based on the following parameters: “Teaching, Learning and Resources (TLR),” “Research and Professional Practices (RPC),” “Graduation Outcomes (GO),” “Outreach and Inclusivity (OI),” and “Perception”.

In NIRF 2022 Pharmacy Category, National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, SAS Nagar has been ranked 4th, preceded by Jamia Hamdard, National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Hyderabad and Panjab University among 400 participating institutions in this category. In NIRF 2021, NIPER SAS Nagar was ranked 4th.
