One Day Institutional Visit under Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) Policy of SERB (Science and Engineering Research Board)

One day institutional visit for under-graduate students (Pharmacy / Life Sciences) under Scientific Social Responsibility (SSR) policy of Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB) was organized at NIPER, SAS Nagar. Applications were invited from undergraduate students of different colleges of the tri-city and nearby areas and thirty three students were shortlisted. Initially, the students were given induction of the activities of different departments by showing them a short movie of the institute. This was followed by their visit to different departments of the institute. The students visited the Central Instruments Laboratory where they were shown the working of sophisticated instruments. The group visited the Technology Development Centres (API and Dosage form) where they were shown infrastructure required to scale up production. They were also made aware of the regulatory requirements for pharmaceutical production. They also visited the Department of Biotechnology and were apprised of different tools used in life sciences and the working of Biosafety Level 2 laboratory. The students visited the Pharmaceutical Heritage Centre where they were provided with knowledge about the history of pharmaceutical sciences in India and the world. They were also shown glimpses of original manuscripts and historical artefacts. At the end of the day, a quiz was organized to assess their gain in knowledge with their visit. The winners of the quiz were awarded with the prizes and certificates.
