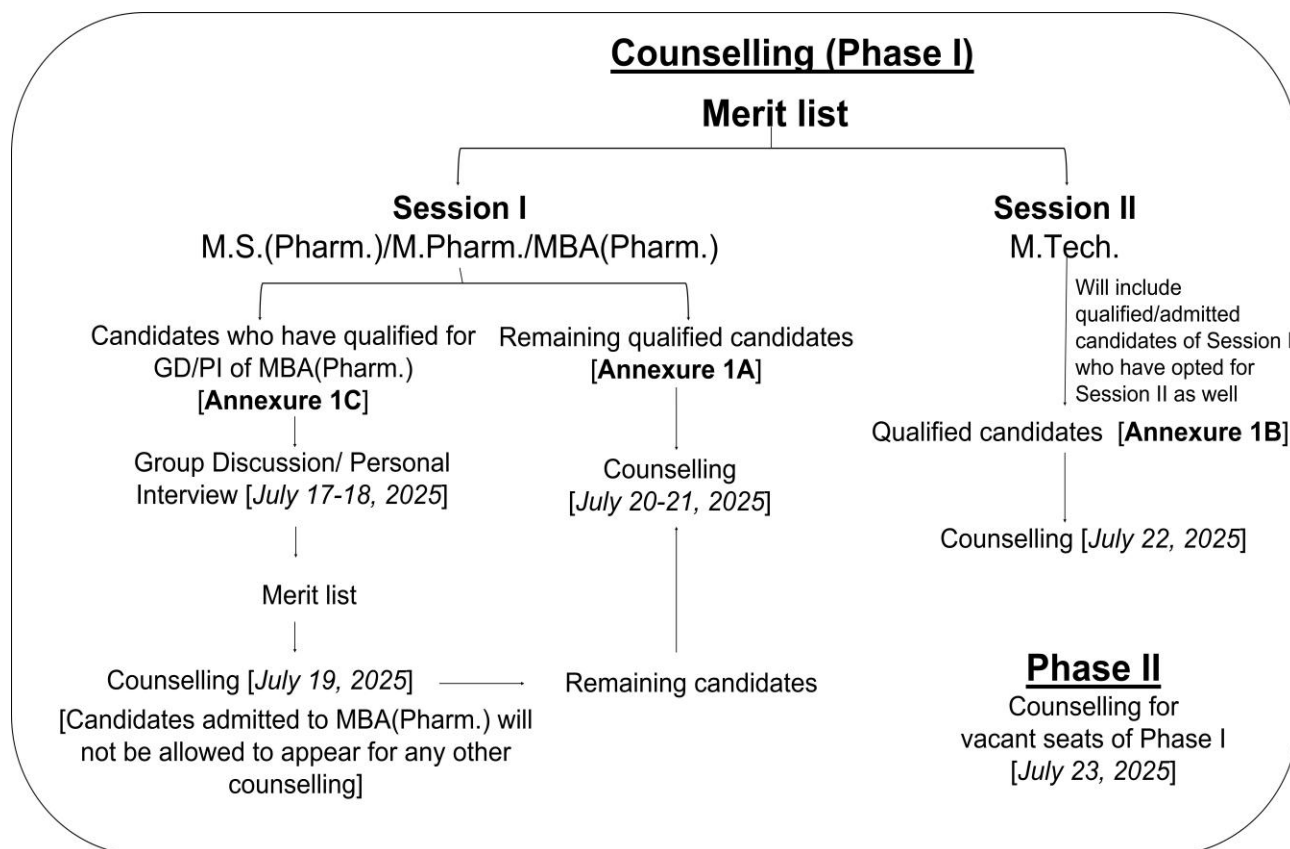

Instructions and Modalities for Physical Counselling



MBA Counselling Process

- 450 candidates (against various reservation categories) among the MBA(Pharm.) list will be called for the Group Discussion (GD)/Personal Interview on **17th & 18th July 2025**. Based on the cumulative score obtained in the CBT and GD, a separate **Merit List** will be released for the MBA (Pharm.) for counselling scheduled on 19th July, 2025 for 90 seats (50 Seats in NIPER Mohali and 40 Seats in NIPER Hyderabad).
- Candidates must pay the requisite fees as mentioned in the brochure of Master Programme in Page No. 42 for confirmation of the allotted seat. Failure to pay at the time of counselling will result in the seat being forfeited and the same will be allotted to the next candidate in the merit list.
- Candidates who have opted for MBA (Pharm.) and have paid the fees **will not be allowed** for further M.S. (Pharm.)/M.Pharm./M.Tech. counselling. However, candidates who were not allotted a seat in MBA (Pharm.) will be allowed for further counselling process of M.S. (Pharm.) / M.Pharm. / M.Tech programmes tentatively scheduled from **20th July 2025**.

M.S. (Pharm.) / M.Pharm. Counselling Process

- Based on **Annexure IA**, counselling for M.S. (Pharm.) / M.Pharm. programmes will be held from **20th to 21st July 2025** for 605 seats available in all the NIPERs. List of candidates is attached in **Annexure 1A**.
- Candidates must pay the requisite fees as mentioned in the brochure of Master Programme in Page No. 41 for confirmation of the allotted seat. Failure to pay at the time of counselling will result in the seat being forfeited and the same will be allotted to the next candidate in the merit list.

M.Tech. Counselling Process

Based on the Merit List of Session-II listed in **Annexure 1B** for M.Tech. [(Biotechnology/Pharmaceutical Technology (Biotechnology)], M.Tech. [Pharmaceutical Technology (Process Chemistry)/Medicinal Chemistry], M.Tech. Medical Devices and PG Diploma in Medical Devices, counselling for 267 seats will be held on **22nd July 2025**.

Note: Candidates who are allotted the seat in M.S. (Pharm.) / M.Pharm. programmes but also opted for Session II programmes during the application process **will be allowed** for Phase II counselling scheduled on **23rd July 2025** without any additional fees.

Phase-2 Counselling

Vacant seats in M.S. (Pharm.) / M.Pharm. programmes due to switching of candidates from Session-1 programmes to Session II programmes will be filled in Phase-II counselling tentatively scheduled on **23rd July 2025**.

Note:

- Candidates who have paid the fee after confirmation of the seat in Session I may also register for Phase 2 counselling, in case they are willing to opt for vacant seat without any additional fee by registering using the link <https://niper.gov.in/niperjee2025/> (will be activated on 22nd July 2025).
- Candidates who are not registered in the link given for phase 2 counselling are not allowed for phase 2 counselling process.
- If a candidate finds any discrepancy against their hall ticket number or reservation category, they may communicate the same via email to 2025niperjee@gmail.com on or before 30th June 2025. Otherwise, the data will be considered as final.
- The proposed dates for counselling as well as GD/personal interview are based on the understanding that GPAT 2025 results will be declared on or before 25th June 2025 (as per information on the website of NBEMS).

Physical Interview and Counselling for Ph.D. Programmes

Physical interview for the short-listed candidates (**Annexure 2**) who have opted for Ph.D. programmes will be held tentatively on 17th and 18th July 2025. Considering the cumulative score from CBT and interview, a separate merit list will be released for each Ph.D. programme and counselling for those candidates will be conducted on **19th July 2025**. Candidates need to pay the prescribed fee as mentioned in the PhD brochure, page No. 40 to confirm the seat.

Essential Documents Required by the time of Physical Counselling for Masters and PhD programmes

Candidates are required to bring original and a self-attested photocopy of all the documents mentioned in the hall ticket. In addition, the candidates must bring a self-attested copy of their **Rank Cards** which can be downloaded from the NIPER JEE 2025 website.

Payment of fees

Candidates need to pay the prescribed fee as mentioned in the respective brochure to confirm the seat. Details of mode of payment will be informed in the next public notice. Candidates are advised to check NIPER-JEE-2025 website regularly.

Note:

1. If any candidate fails to submit the valid caste certificate as per the required format, reservation claim will not be applicable, and the same candidate will be considered under the general category.
2. Failure to submit any of the above document (s) during the counselling will result in the application being considered incomplete and the candidate is not allowed to participate for further counselling. Request for an extension of the date of submission for the deficit documents as per the above table will also not be entertained.
3. In all matters related to NIPER JEE 2025, decisions of the Competent Authority of the Institute shall be final and binding.
